Gradel, based in France's Savoie region, had revenues of FF 110 million in 1999 and a workforce of 180. Revenues of FF 125 million and an EBITDA margin of at least 20% are expected in 2000. Gradel has unique expertise in machining complex parts with long production runs, used by automotive-parts suppliers.

Former has acquired Gradel as part of its strategy to develop a business supplying high value-added parts to global automotive-parts manufacturers. Former had revenues of FF 1.1 billion in 1999 and a workforce of 1,600.

GFI Industries will consolidate the newly-acquired companies as of January 1, 2000. The acquisition will be financed with existing cash and be earnings-enhancing from the first year.
