



## LISI AEROSPACE OPENS A MANUFACTURING UNIT IN MONTREAL

As of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2005, LISI AEROSPACE will manufacture aerospace fasteners in Canada (Montreal – Quebec) mainly targeted at North American markets specializing in engines and criticals.

For several years, LISI AEROSPACE has been developing its activities in North America, partnering with engine, equipment and aircraft manufacturers. Now, LISI AEROSPACE is seeking to gain market share in these different markets.

LISI AEROSPACE already has two units based in California, which deal in structural fasteners for airframes and special fasteners mainly for aircraft interior fittings. It needed to extend its range of products manufactured locally in order to strengthen its activities in this part of the world.

This unit managed by Mr Farrell Campbell, makes up the Engine &Criticals BU – North America, and is the counterpart of Engine &Criticals BU - Europe. Based in Dorval, the premises are 4 535 m<sup>2</sup> and will include all the necessary means of producing high technology parts with critical applications.

This project results from a fruitful collaboration between LISI AEROSPACE and the Ministry of the Economic development, Innovation and Exports in Quebec, as well as its agency dedicated to financing companies, Investment Quebec.

LISI AEROSPACE whose Head Office is located in Paris, employs over 2 300 people and operates in continental Europe, England, Mexico, Turkey, USA and now Canada.
